**Tall Timbers Treehouse** is a multi-level play structure with water.

**The Boogie Bear Surf** offers guests a continual sheet wave for body boarding and surfing.

The **Tak-it-eesi-Creek** adventure river allows guests to float leisurely in inflatable tubes while being sprayed by water.

**Lott-a-watta-Bay** has cliff like rock formations, which spills water into lagoon.

The **Avalanche family raft ride** holds up to four people as they adventure down a winding slide with a 41-foot drop that simulates a white water rafting adventure.

**Glacier Run and Snow Shoe Falls** are two tube-shaped water slides which take guests through curls and tunnels culminating in a shallow catch pool.

**We will be providing at least one counselor for every two children, but most will be one-on-one. You need to bring a bathing suit and clothing for two days. Accommodations will be provided in the lodge. Because it is only overnight, stipends will be \$125 for Head Counselors and \$75 for Assistant Counselors. All transportation, fees, sleeping arrangements and meals will be provided. Please have applications in by Monday, February 14.**
